Garbage:

Keep indoor trash cans and recycling contained and orderly. Keep studio related trash in our studio prior to dumpster. All garbage is taken out **behind the building where our dumpster and recycling can** is located. This backlot + dumpster is *shared* with Roboto. It is also gated with a lock to prevent external dumping by outsiders. Let the team know if the dumpster is full --if so, carefully and discretely store additional bags behind cement alcove. Bunker team members will handle event related trash.

Public Transit info: Bus Route + Cost

88 route goes down Penn Ave but you can also pick up the 64 by the Children's Hospital. \$2.75 per ride in cash (\$2.50 + \$1 for transfers with card, available at the Market District Giant Eagle)
